2021 LAJUF CLASS SPECIFICATIONS and YEA Divisions

<u>LEADLINE WALK DIVISION: (classes 54, 55, 56, 57).</u> Open to riders <u>8 & under</u> who have not shown at the trot in any horse show. Cannot cross enter at this show with <u>any other classes</u>. Judged on <u>EQUITATION</u> in all classes. Safe dress, approved hard hat, and paddock shoes or boots required. Leadline <u>Trot & Poles</u> at Walk will be done individually <u>on lead line</u> in front of judge.

<u>WALK-TROT DIVISION: 9 & UNDER</u>: (58-61) (Poles or X's – specify on entry) An <u>equitation division</u> open to riders who have not shown at the canter. Judged on manners and suitability of mount <u>in pleasure class</u>. rider's position, balance, and effectiveness in <u>all other classes</u>. Trotting preferred over walk in O/F classes. Continued cantering is penalized in over-fence classes. NO cross-entries.

<u>WALK-TROT DIVISION, 10 & OVER: (67-70)</u> Same as above, except limited to riders 10 & over. No cross-entries w/other divisions.

<u>CROSS RAILS HUNTER & EQUITATION (26-31)</u> OPEN TO <u>VERY BEGINNER RIDERS</u> who have not shown over fences above 18".

<u>OPTIONS: MAY trot in 1st fence of all lines and canter out; MAY trot entire course, OR MAY canter entire course</u>. Choice is judged on <u>CONSISTENCY</u> throughout <u>course</u>. Can cross-enter with HOPEFUL (@ cross rails only) Flat classes at walk, trot & canter. No green horses in U/S class. Canter will be split if numbers warrant (10 or more). Proper dress required.

<u>MULTI-TALENTED EQUINE</u> (62-66) 18", 2' or 2'3") Open to horses or ponies: Flat classes: walk, trot & canter. Obedience class based on promptness of request. Hunter & Equitation O/F <u>may trot OR canter</u>. Pleasure class emphasis on manners. Jumpers may not show in any other <u>JUMPER</u> class at this show above 18".. TBL II jumper rules. Jumper class is a BLUE ribbon round; no time taken. Points go to Horse. Professionals may ride N.A.G. (No Award Given)

<u>HOPEFUL HUNTER & EQUITATION:</u> (32-37) (<u>Cross rails or 18</u>") Horses or Ponies; no restrictions as to previous height. Horse/rider cannot show in any class higher than 2' at this show. <u>MUST trot in, MAY canter out</u>. Professionals may ride in Hunter but NOT Equitation classes. Flat classes judged walk-trot-canter. Proper dress required.

<u>LONG STIRRUP/SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER & EQUITATION (38-43)</u>: 18" – will be split <u>Long & Short</u> if numbers warrant. Canter entire class with lead changes. **May cross enter with HOPEFUL and MTE at 18" only.** No professionals.

<u>PRE-CHILDREN'S/ADULT HUNTER & EQUITATION</u> (44-49) 2' OR 2'3 - Open to Junior or Adult Amateurs <u>who do not show above 2'3 at this show.</u> May NOT cross enter with Children's/Adult. Proper dress required. No professionals. Choose height.

<u>CHILDREN'S/ADULT HUNTER & EQUITATION:</u> (9-14) (2'6, 2'9 or 3') Open to **JUNIOR OR ADULT AMATEURS**; no distance changes for ponies. Hunters judged on manners, performance and soundness. May not cross enter with Pre-Children;s/Adult. Proper dress required. No professionals. **Choose height.**

LAJUF HIGH EQUITATION MEDAL: (15): (2'6, 2'9 or 3') Open to JUNIOR or ADULT AMATEUR riders. NO ponies due to combinations. May be required to return for additional individual work. May NOT cross enter with Low Equitation Medal.. Finals will be held at November show Proper dress required.

LAJUF LOW EQUITATION MEDAL: (50) (18", 2' OR 2'3: Open to JUNIOR or ADULT AMATEUR riders. May NOT cross enter with High Equitation Medal. Finals held at November show. Proper dress required. Test is included in original course.

OPEN MODIFIED HUNTER: (105-107): (2',2'3,2'6) Open to professionals; horses or ponies, no restrictions as to previous height. Trotting and cantering over fences judged equally. Judged on manners, performance, consistency, and soundness. Proper dress BABY GREEN HUNTER: (22-25) 2'3" Open to horses or ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing fences 2'3 or higher. Trotting and cantering judged equally; smoothness and consistency paramount. Proper dress required. Flat judged at W-T-C. LOW HUNTER (1-4) 2'3 or 2'6: Open to horses or ponies of any experience. Judged on manners, performance & soundness. No distance changes for ponies. Choose height. Proper dress required.

SCHOOLING HUNTER: (5-8) 2'9 or 3'. Open to horses or ponies of any experience. Judged on manners, performance & soundness. No distance changes for ponies. Choose height. Proper dress required.

PONY HUNTER: (50-53): 2'3 or 2'6 Open to ponies only. To be judged on manners, performance & soundness. Proper dress required.

<u>WARMUP CLASSES</u> are judged and will receive a <u>BLUE ribbon for scores 75%</u> and over. <u>Open all heights, all day; same horse/rider.</u>

THOROUGHBRED INCENTIVE CLASSES: Dressage: Intro-First Level (#383-392); Open Dressage (#896-398) 2-4th Level; Open TB Hunter, choose height, 2'6 or 3' Open card with respective heights (#201-203); Very Green Hunter at 2' (#205-207); Hopeful Jumper at 2'6 (#274-276); Schooling Jumper 2' (277-279). TIP High Point Awards given by Jockey Club; Not LAJUF.

BGINNER JUMPERS: (#16, #17) 18" ONLY – H/R CANNOT cross enter with any jumper class above 18". Excessive speed or dangerous riding will be penalized at discretion of Judge (4 or 8 faults). #16 - TBL II (not timed); #17: - TBL II 2.1

All other 1st rounds of <u>Jumper divisions</u> will be Clear Rounds; 2nd class Tbl. II, 2b; 3rd class Tbl II, Sec.1 <u>LOW JUMPERS:</u> (71-73) 2'3" Open to horses & ponies. H/R combination <u>may not cross enter</u> with **ANY** other <u>jumper division at this</u> show. May do hunters and equitation at higher level.

TRAINING JUMPERS: (74-76) 2'6" Open to horses & ponies.

SCHOOLING JUMPER: (77-79) 2'9 or 3': Open to horses or ponies; No restrictions as to previous experience. Choose height. OPEN JUMPER: (80-82) 3'3 or 3'6 Open to horses or ponies; No restrictions as to previous experience. Choose height.

3 DRESSAGE DIVISIONS FOR LAJUF YEAR END AWARDS: INTRO, TRAINING, & FIRST LEVEL All tests: USDF 2019: or USEA 2018 (Eventing) INTRO: A, B, C * Training Level: 1-3 * First Level: 1-3

Horses must enter at least TWO SHOWS in a division to keep Year End Award Points in that division.
