2018 LAJUF Hunter/Jumper/Dressage RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. <u>SHOW FEES</u>: Hunter/Jumper/Equitation: \$15.00 per class if entry in office by 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday before show. Email, .Fax or mail; no telephone entries accepted. Late fee: \$3.00 per class. Fax number: 352-799-4642. **Dressage:** \$20.00 per class through 1st level.; \$30.00 above 1st level. Late fee: \$10.00 per horse <u>Dressage entries & fees</u> must be in office <u>one week prior</u> to show date.
- 2. STALL FEES: Must be paid or stalls will not be held. Refunds given if cancelled before Tuesday noon. Barn will be charged.
- 3. LATE ENTRY FEES will be enforced. Reserving stalls will not eliminate late fees.-
- 4. <u>ADDS/SCRATCHES</u> MUST BE DONE IN OFFICE! It is **YOUR** responsibility to notify the office & paddock before the class is complete. A \$5.00 fee PER CLASS will be charged <u>if you fail</u> to notify the office. Add-Scratch sheet MUST be filled out. Scratches done correctly do incur a one-time \$5.00 scratch fee.
- 5. <u>APPROVED ASTM HELMETS</u> and PROPER FOOTWEAR must be worn at all times by ALL RIDERS when mounted as per USEF 2006 ruling. .
- 6. <u>DRESSAGE:</u> Must be pre-entered for scheduling and pre-paid. Post entries only if time allows. Post Entry fee: \$10.00 additional per class.
- 7. SPLITTING CLASSES: All classes age 14 & under will be split at 16; cantering split at 10; Age 10 & under, California split at 13.
- 8. <u>NUMBERS</u> will not be given out until release forms and current year applications are signed completely and payment (cash or an open check made out to LAJUF, INC.) has been left in office. <u>Returned Checks</u> will be charged an additional \$25.00 fee. ENTRY MUST HAVE CORRECT NUMBER! (MAY result in elimination). PLEASE CHECK the BACK OF NUMBER for classes!
- 9. PRIZES (trophy, plate, prize of the day, tack shop chit for \$5.00, or a show credit chit for \$5.00) will be awarded in all classes with three entries or more. CHAMPIONSHIPS given in all divisions with three or more entries.
- 10. ENTRIES: ONLY ONE HORSE/RIDER PER ENTRY FORM! Each entry must pay office fee of \$10.00.
- 11. <u>DRESS CODE</u>: Proper dress is required in all Hunter & Equitation classes. Coats may be waived in warm weather.

 Jumper riders may wear Polo shirts. All riders must wear ASTM-approved headgear while mounted as per 2006

 USEF ruling. (Sports bras are not appropriate dress, even on warmup days.)
- 12. SCHOOLING is available Friday at 2:00 p.m. to dusk and on Saturday & Sunday from daylight until ring drag and in evenings until 6:30 pm or dusk in winter times. If water truck or tractor enters ring, riders must give way until truck leaves ring. Schooling fee is \$15.00 for EACH horse/rider combination, excluding flat classes. Non-stabled horses pay a "per-day" fee. Schooling will be charged for over-fence entriesunless trainer/rider/parent lets office know beforehand.

No schooling is permitted in dressage ring. Dressage warmup is in private upper grass ring or in front of the Fannin's house.

- 13. NEGATIVE COGGINS must be AVAILABLE for each horse on grounds. Do not bother to send with entry.
- 14. HEIGHT OPTION CLASSES: PLEASE Notify paddock master of height choice at least one hour before start of class.
- **15. STALL FEES:** \$35.00 for duration of show. Tack stalls will not be split and will be charged to first horse on trainer's list unless otherwise indicated. Fees must be sent in early to secure stalls on 1st in-1st served basis. Refunds given if called in by Tuesday noon before show date. No refunds after that date unless stall can be filled. Barns will be charged.
- **16. NON-STABLED HORSES:** \$15.00 per day per horse.
- 17. RULES are based on the USEF Conflicts will be resolved by the Show Committee.
- 18. <u>CROSS ENTERING:</u> You may cross enter in flat classes, (Under Saddle and Equitation) if class is EQUAL or ABOVE your jumping division and you are otherwise qualified. (No adults in underage; no professionals in Childrens, etc. unless NAG, (No Award Given) This is to give beginner riders more mileage, while protecting them in their own divisions). Professionals or experienced riders must go NAG
- 19. TRAILERS IN TRAILER FIELD ONLY! NO CARS between barns w/o paid camp fee. Do not block ingress or egress of cars or trailers. TRAILERS for CAMPING ONLY MUST HAVE PERMIT to park in barn area. See office if campsite available.
- 20. <u>NON-SHOWING HORSE</u> will be required to pay <u>Stabling or fee</u>, Non-Show fee (\$25.00), Office fee, and Schooling fee if rings or jumps are used. ALL horses must have a number and it must be worn while being ridden.
- 21. <u>RELEASE FORMS</u> must be signed by <u>adult rider</u>, or <u>parent or <u>legal</u> <u>guardian</u> of minor. Trainer's signature is not legal unless accompanied by notarized "Power of Attorney". **DO NOT FAX**. Bring original to show; will keep on file for 1 year.</u>
- 22. <u>CLEAN STALLS:</u> We would appreciate your picking up your stalls and leaving them clean for the next showt. It will help us keep prices down. Thank you! Place manure in designated pile.
- 23. BEDDING is available for purchase at \$7.00 bag.
- 24. HORSE and/or RIDER'S NAME must be correct. Computer does not keep track of variations of show name

YEAR END AWARDS

MEMBER APPLICATIONS: SHEETS MUST BE FILLED IN COMPLETELY WITH CORRECT NAMES, ADDRESSES, AGE OF RIDER, PHONE NUMBERS, AND BARN AFFILIATIONS. \$15 member Fee will be collected for all riders at 1st show. PLEASE CHECK EACH SHOW and report discrepancies to office personnel. HORSE/RIDER MUST SHOW IN AT LEAST TWO (2) SHOWS IN A DIVISION TO KEEP POINTS IN THAT DIVISION FOR YEA'S.
