## 2018 LAJUF CLASS SPECIFICATIONS and YEA Divisions

LEADLINE WALK DIVISION: (classes 54, 55, 56, 57) Open to riders 8 & under who have not shown at the trot in any horse show. Cannot cross enter at this show with any other classes. Judged on EQUITATION in all classes. Safe dress, approved hard hat, and paddock shoes or boots required. Leadline Trot & Poles will be individually on lead line in front of judge.

WALK-TROT DIVISION: 9 & UNDER: (58-61) (Poles or X's - specify on entry) An equitation division open to riders who have not shown at the canter. Judged on manners and suitability of mount in pleasure class; rider's position, balance, and effectiveness in all other classes. Trotting preferred over walk in O/F classes. Continued cantering is penalized in over-fence classes. NO cross-entries. WALK-TROT DIVISION, 10 & OVER:(67-70) Same as above, except limited to riders 10 & over. No cross-entries w/other divisions. CROSS RAILS HUNTER & EQUITATION (26-31) OPEN TO VERY BEGINNER RIDERS who have not shown over fences above 18".

OPTIONS: MAY trot in 1<sup>st</sup> fence of all lines and canter out; MAY trot entire course, OR MAY canter entire course. Choice is judged on CONSISTENCY throughout course. Can cross-enter with HOPEFUL and Beginner Combined (at 18" only). Flat classes at walk, trot & canter. No green horses in U/S class. Canter will be split if numbers warrant (10 or more) Proper dress required.

MULTI-TALENTED EQUINE (62-66) (18", 2', OR 2'3") Open to horses or ponies: Flat classes: walk, trot & canter. Obedience class based on promptness of request. Hunter & Equitation O/F may trot OR canter. Pleasure class emphasis on manners. Jumpers may not show in any other JUMPER class at this show (other than INTRO to Jumpers at 10" or 18".) TBL II jumper rules. Jumper class is a BLUE ribbon round; no time taken.. Points go to Horse. Professionals may ride N.A.G.

HOPEFUL HUNTER & EQUITATION: (32-37) (Cross rails or 18") Horses or Ponies; no restrictions as to previous height. Horse/rider cannot show in any class higher than 2' at this show. MUST trot in, MAY canter out. Professionals may ride in Hunter but NOT Equitation classes. Flat classes judged walk-trot-canter. Proper dress required.

LONG STIRRUP-SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER & EQUITATION (38-43): 18" - will be split Long & Short if numbers warrant. Canter entire class with lead changes. May only cross enter with HOPEFUL OR PRE-CHILDREN'S/ADULT Divisions. Expected to walk, trot and canter on correct lead. No professionals.

PRE-CHILDREN'S/ADULT HUNTER & EQUITATION (44-49) 2' OR 2'3 - Open to riders who have not shown above 2'3 within 5 yrs. May NOT cross enter with Children's/Adult . Proper dress required. No professionals.

CHILDREN'S/ADULT HUNTER & EQUITATION: 9-14)(2'6, 2'9 or 3') Open to JUNIOR OR ADULT AMATEURS; no distance changes for ponies. Judged on manners, performance and soundness. Proper dress required. Choose height.

\*\*LAJUF HIGH EQUITATION MEDAL: (2'6, 2'9 or 3') Open to JUNIOR or ADULT AMATEUR riders. NO ponies due to combinations. May be required to return for additional individual work. Finals will be held at November show Proper dress required.

\*\*LAJUF LOW EQUITATION MEDAL: (2' or 2'3") Open to JUNIOR or ADULT AMATEUR riders. Horses & ponies allowed, as there are no combinations; May be required to return for additional individual work. Finals held at November show. Proper dress required. \*\*Riders may show in both Medals during the year, but qualifiers for MEDAL FINALS, MUST CHOOSE HIGH or LOW.

OPEN MODIFIED HUNTER: (105-107): Open to professionals; horses or ponies, no restrictions as to previous height. Judged on manners, performance and soundess.

BABY GREEN HUNTER: (22-25) 2'3" Open to horses or ponies in their 1<sup>st</sup> or 2nd year of showing fences 2'3 or higher. Trotting and cantering judged equally; smoothness and consistency paramount. Proper dress required. Flat judged at walk-trot-canter.

LOW HUNTER (1-4) 2'3 or 2'6: Open to horses or ponies of any experience. Judged on manners, performance & soundness. No distance changes for ponies. **Choose height.** Proper dress required.

SCHOOLING HUNTER: (5-8) 2'9 or 3' Open to horses or ponies of any experience. Judged on manners, performance & soundness. Choose height. Proper dress required.

**PONY HUNTER:** (2'3 or 2'6) Open to ponies only. To be judged on manners, performance & soundness. Proper dress required.

WARMUP CLASSES are judged and will receive a BLUE ribbon for scores 75% and over. Open all heights, all day ; one horse/rider.

## **JUMPERS**

## All first rounds of Jumper divisions will be Clear Rounds; 2<sup>nd</sup> class Tbl. II, 2b; 3<sup>rd</sup> class Tbl II, Sec.1

LOW JUMPERS: (2'3) Open to horses & ponies. H/R combination may not cross enter with ANY other

jumper division at this show. May do hunters and equitation at higher level.

TRAINING JUMPERS: (2'6) Open to horses & ponies. Cannot cross enter with 2'3 Jumpers.

SCHOOLING JUMPER: (2'9 or 3') Open to horses or ponies; Cannot cross enter 2'3 jumpers. No restrictions as

to previous experience. Choose height.

OPEN JUMPER: (3'3 or 3'6) Open to horses or ponies; cannot enter 2'3 Jumpers. No restrictions as to

previous experience. Choose height.

INTRO TO JUMPERS: Clear rounds receive blue ribbons; not timed: 10", 18", 2' (NOT a Year End Award division) Dangerous riding may eliminate. Class is held 2-3 times a year.
