

2026 LAJUF Hunter/Jumper/Dressage RULES & REGULATIONS

- CLASS FEES:** Hunter/Jumper/Equitation: \$15.00 per class if entry in office by 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday before show. Dressage: \$25.00 per class Intro through 1st level; \$30.00 above 1st level and all USEA, or Gaited. Dressage entries and class fees must be received ONE WEEK prior to show date. Cash, open check, or credit card accepted. Returned checks will be charged \$25 fee. Email entries as attachment: Horseshows@Lajuf.com or mail; 29499 Wildlife Lane, Brooksville, FL 34602.
NO TELEPHONE ENTRIES ACCEPTED. NO CALLS AFTER 8:00 pm.
- LATE ENTRIES:** HORSE SHOW HUNTER/JUMPER/EQUITATION CLASS Entries received after 6:00 pm the Wednesday before the show will be charged an additional \$3.00 per class. DRESSAGE: Late entries only accepted if ride time available and late fee is additional \$10.00 per class.
- SHOW SCRATCH:** Hunter/Jumper scratches must be received by noon the Tuesday before show. Office fee and stall fee will be charged if later. Dressage scratches must be received by noon the Saturday before show in order to receive class refund. See #13.
- CLASS ADDS/SCRATCHES MUST BE DONE IN OFFICE!** It is YOUR responsibility to notify the office & paddock. You will be charged class fee if you fail to notify office before class. Class scratches DO incur a one-time \$5.00 scratch fee.
- SHOW FEES:** An office fee will be charged for each horse/rider entry at each show. A schooling fee will be charged at each show for each horse/rider combination that uses the ring at any time other than a class. A LAJUF membership application will be charged annually for each horse/rider combination.
- CHECKOUT:** Please wait ½ hour after your division has pinned to check out.
- SPLITTING CLASSES:** Splitting classes at management discretion or at 16 horses.
- NUMBERS** will not be given out until release forms and current year applications are signed completely and payment (cash, open check to LAJUF, INC. or credit card number) has been left in office. Returned Checks will be charged an additional \$25.00 fee. **ENTRY MUST WEAR CORRECT NUMBER WHILE MOUNTED!** (May result in elimination). PLEASE CHECK back of number for classes and make corrections in office.
- PRIZES:** (Trophy, plate, prize of the day, tack shop chit for \$5.00, or a show credit chit for \$5.00) will be awarded in all non-TIP classes with three entries or more. CHAMPIONSHIP RIBBONS given in all divisions with three or more entries.
- ENTRIES: ONLY ONE HORSE/RIDER PER ENTRY FORM!** Each H/R entry must pay office fee & schooling fee.
- DRESS CODE:** Proper dress is required in all Hunter & Equitation classes. Coats may be waived in warm weather. Standard jumper attire is required in all jumper classes. **All riders must wear ASTM-approved headgear** while mounted. (Sports bras are not appropriate dress, even on warmup days.)
- SCHOOLING** is available Friday 1:00 pm-6:00 and on Saturday & Sunday from daylight until ring drag and in evenings until 6:00 pm or dusk in winter times. **If water truck or tractor enters ring, riders must give way until truck leaves ring.** Schooling fee is charged for EACH horse/rider combination, excluding flat classes. **NO JUMPING OVER CROSS-COUNTRY FENCES and NO RIDING IN DRESSAGE RING BEFORE SHOW.** Dressage warmup is in private upper grass ring, or in front of the main house.
- STALL FEES:** \$60.00 for duration of show. Tack stalls will not be split and will be charged to Barn or 1st horse on trainer's list unless otherwise indicated. Fees must be sent in early to secure stalls on 1st come, 1st served basis. Refunds given if scratched by Tuesday noon before show date. No refunds after that date unless stall can be filled. Barns will be charged.
- NON-STABLED HORSES:** \$25.00 per horse for duration of show.
- RULES** are based on the USEF. Conflicts will be resolved by the Show Committee.
- CROSS ENTERING:** You may cross enter in flat classes, (Under Saddle and Equitation) if class is EQUAL or ABOVE your jumping division and you are otherwise qualified. No adults in underage; no professionals in Childrens, etc. unless NAG, (NO AWARD GIVEN). This is to give beginner riders mileage, while protecting them in their own divisions).
- TRAILERS IN TRAILER FIELD ONLY!** NO CARS between barns w/o paid camp fee. Do not block ingress or egress of cars or trailers. See office if campsite available.
- NON-SHOWING HORSE** will be required to pay **Stabling or day fee, Non-Show fee (\$50.00), Office fee, and Schooling fee** if rings or jumps are used. ALL horses must have a number and it must be worn while being ridden.
- RELEASE FORMS** must be signed by adult rider, or parent or legal guardian of minor. Trainer's signature is not acceptable unless accompanied by notarized "Power of Attorney". **DO NOT FAX**. Bring original to show; will keep on file for show year.
- SHARING HORSE:** All competitors must pay office fee, schooling fees, class fees and other applicable fees.
- HORSE and/or RIDER'S NAME must be correct.** Computer does not keep track of variations of show name. \$5.00 fee/change.
- NEGATIVE COGGINS** must be AVAILABLE for each horse on grounds. Do not send with entry.
- HEIGHT OPTION CLASSES:** PLEASE Notify paddock master of height choice before start of class.
- JUMP HEIGHT VARIATIONS:** USEF regulations allow for a 2" height variation at all height levels.
- WESTERN TACK:** Western tack is allowed in the MTE Obedience and Pleasure classes and the Dressage Suitability and Pattern classes.
- DOGS:** All dogs must remain leashed at all times.

YEAR END AWARDS

MEMBER APPLICATIONS: SHEETS MUST BE FILLED IN COMPLETELY WITH CORRECT NAMES, ADDRESSES, AGE OF RIDER, PHONE NUMBERS, AND BARN AFFILIATIONS. \$15 member Fee will be collected for all riders at 1st show. CHECK POINTS EACH SHOW and report discrepancies to office personnel. **HORSE/RIDER MUST SHOW IN AT LEAST TWO (2) SHOWS IN A DIVISION TO KEEP POINTS IN THAT DIVISION FOR YEA'S. POINTS ARE AWARDED** as follows: 1st-10; 2nd- 6; 3rd -4; 4th- 2; 5th-1; 6th - ½
